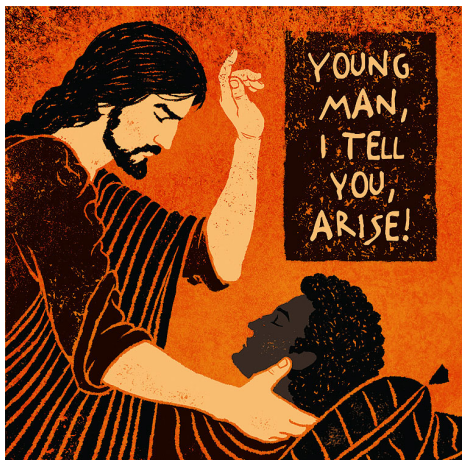

Jubilee of Mercy

Dear Friends in Christ,

On the weekend of June 11-12, 2016, we will take up a special collection for the **Retired Priests of the Archdiocese**.

Throughout the year, I have had several opportunities to meet many of our 206 retired priests who continue to share their priestly ministry in our parishes. It has come to my attention that many parishes depend upon their service for daily and Sunday Masses and for countless funerals. Without the help of our retired priests many parishes would have to reduce Mass schedules and other sacramental services.

In April, it was my honor to celebrate the funeral Mass for Monsignor Richard O'Donnell, our oldest priest. Monsignor O'Donnell was 105 years old when he died. He was ordained a priest in 1935, which means he served as a priest of Chicago for almost 81 years. He spent his retirement years at Our Lady of Good Counsel Parish where he had been pastor. Parishioners visited him every day and somewhere in that time his ministry was returned to him through their care and love.

Our retired priests rely upon your help now. The Priests' Retirement and Mutual Aid Association (PRMAA) cares for our retired priests. As you know the costs for health care, prescription drugs and nursing home care continues to increase. This special collection in June is different from the December collection for retired men and women religious where the collection goes to those in religious orders; Archdiocesan priests do not receive any funds from that collection.

Many thanks to all of you for your most gracious generosity in this collection last year and I ask that you repeat that kindness this year. Your donations, your prayers, and your good wishes are an affirmation of our retired priests. With this letter, I wish to take this opportunity to share my heartfelt appreciation for the ministry and devotion of our retired priests and I ask you to remember all the faithful priests who have gone to their eternal reward. Jubileusz Miłosierdzia

Drodzy Przyjaciele w Chrystusie,

Podczas weekendu, w dniach 11 i 12 czerwca 2016 roku będzie miała miejsce specjalna kolekta na rzecz **Księża Emerytów Archidiecezji Chicago**.

W ciągu ostatniego roku kilkakrotnie miałem okazję spotkania wielu, spośród 206 księży emerytów naszej archidiecezji, którzy nie zaprzestali posługi kapłańskiej w naszych parafiach. Dowiedziałem się, że wiele parafii liczy na posługę księży emerytów w odprawianiu codziennych i niedzielnych Mszy św. i w przewodniczeniu niezliczonym pogrzebom. Bez pomocy naszych księży emerytów wiele parafii musiałoby zredukować liczbę Mszy św., odprawianych regularnie i zredukować inne posługi sakramentalne.

W kwietniu dostąpiłem zaszczytu celebrowania Mszy św. pogrzebowej księdza prałata Richarda O'Donnella, naszego najstarszego kapłana. W chwili śmierci ksiądz prałat Richard O'Donnell miał 105 lat. Świecenia kapłańskie przyjął w 1935 roku, co oznacza, że przez niemal 81 lat pełnił w Chicago posługę kapłańską. Swoją emeryturę spędził w parafii Naszej Pani Dobrej Rady, gdzie był proboszczem. Każdego dnia emerytury odwiedzali go tam parafianie. Można powiedzieć, że dobro, które dawał ludziom podczas swojej posługi, wróciło do niego w ofiarowanej mu miłości i opiece.

Nasi księża emeryci liczą na Waszą pomoc. Fundusz Emerytalny i Towarzystwo Ubezpieczeń Wzajemnych Księży (The Priests' Retirement and Mutual Aid Association - PRMAA) dba o zabezpieczanie ich potrzeb. Jak sami dobrze wiecie, wciąż wzrastają koszty opieki zdrowotnej, leków na receptę i utrzymania domów opieki zdrowotnej. Kolekta czerwcową jest czymś innym niż kolekta grudniowa na rzecz osób konsekrowanych, w całości przeznaczona na potrzeby zakonników i zakonnic. Księża diecezjalni nie korzystają z funduszy zgromadzonych podczas tamtej, grudniowej kolekty.

Ogromnie dziękuję Wam wszystkim za najlaskawszą hojność okazaną podczas tej kolekty w ubiegłym roku. Proszę Was o taką samą hojność również w tym roku. Wasze ofiary, modlitwy i życzliwe słowa są wyrazem uznania dla naszych emerytowanych księży. Piszac ten list, pragnę skorzystać z okazji, aby przekazać Państwu moją płynącą z serca wdzięczność za Waszą posługę i oddanie okazywane naszym księżom emerytom. Proszę równocześnie, abyście pamiętali o wszystkich wiernych księżach, którzy odeszli już do wieczności. Życzę Wam wszelkich możliwych łask, z wyrazami szacunku pozostaję,

SUMMERTIME APPROPRIATE CHURCH ATTIRE & BEHAVIOR

With the warm days of summer finally upon us, worshipers are reminded to still dress respectfully at Mass. Our church is air conditioned and comfortable enough for the one hour you will be at Mass. Tank tops, shorts and flip flops are not appropriate. When meeting a very important person, no matter the weather, we would put on our "Sunday Best" to meet them. At Mass, we meet with God Almighty and receive the Body and Blood of our Savior, Jesus Christ. Far above some V.I.P., God deserves our respectful and modest appearance. Remember: there is a reason for the phrase, "Sunday Best!"

By the same token, if you are sensitive to air conditioning, please bring a sweater or light jacket. With attendance at week-end Masses ranging from 200 to 1,200 or more, there is little we can do to quickly regulate the temperature for the number of people in the building.

Several years ago, the Catholic Bishops of the United States reminded Catholics that, while in the worship space of the church building, the time there should be used in holy silence for prayer and reflection before and after Mass. Quickly greeting fellow parishioners is just manners. Carrying on an entire conversation in church is disruptive to others around who are in prayer. If a conversation must be carried on, please take it to one of the five major entrance hallways which our church is blessed with.

We all get into bad habits...even at Mass. A number of our parishioners are in the habit of rushing out of the church immediately after Holy Communion, even though the end of the Mass is only a few minutes away. If we attend a special dinner prepared for us by someone we love, we would never consider standing up from the table when we had enough to eat and bolt out the door without saying "thank you" and staying for dessert. At the Banquet of the Lord, the Jesus we love nourishes us with His Body and Blood for our salvation. Please stay in thanksgiving to, at least, the end of the Mass and even afterward to pray for yourself and your loved ones.



SPIRITUAL REFLECTION - Jubilee of Mercy | June 5 | 10th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Half the liturgical year 2016 is completed after six months of extraordinary celebrations. The Incarnation mystery: Jesus' advent, nativity, epiphany. The Paschal mystery: Jesus' passion, death, resurrection, Pentecost's Holy Spirit. The solemnities of Holy Trinity and Jesus' Body and Blood. Today the Church resumes Sundays in Ordinary Time, but with a Gospel of extraordinary mercy: Jesus raises a dead man to life. Yet the one who benefits most from his extraordinary mercy is not the dead son but his widowed mother. With her husband and only son deceased, this woman's material support, in that

patriarchal society, had vanished. So had her emotional support, leaving her helpless, abandoned, on society's "peripheries." One of Pope Francis' hopes in calling this Extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy is to transform us into more extraordinary Christians, by making our caring outreach to just such vulnerable people, and our practical self-sacrificing love for them, our ordinary, daily, Christian way of life! -Peter Scagnelli, Copyright © J.
