This is a simple, but crucial fundraising effort for the Women's Centers. Thank you for helping defend life!

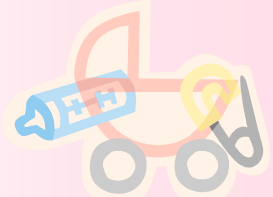


Prosimy wszystkich parafian do współdziału w akcji zbierania funduszy dla Centrum Kobiet.

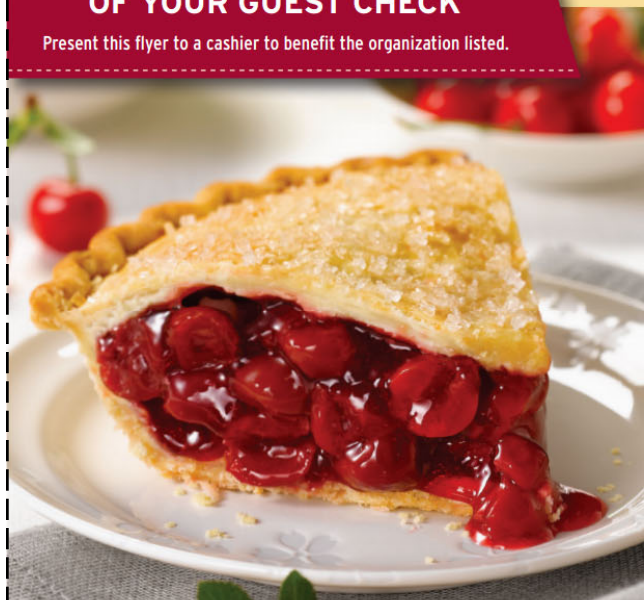

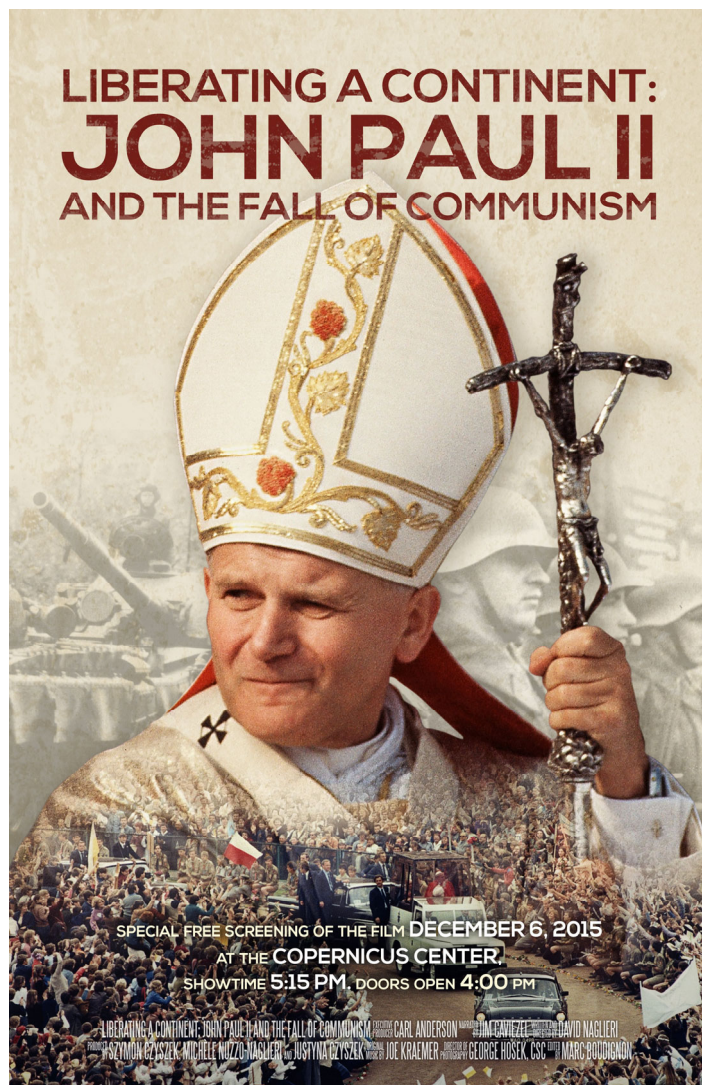

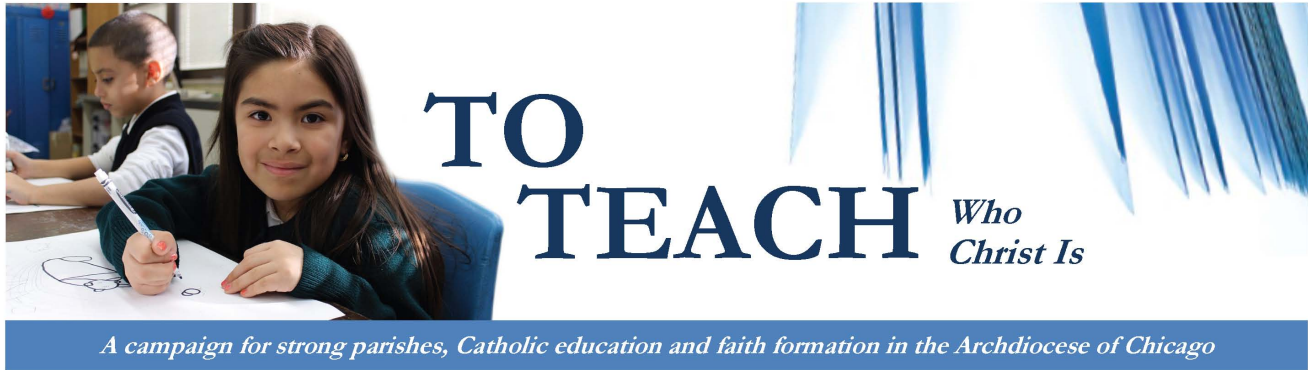

Campaign is moving forward

For the past several weeks, we have been telling you about the *To Teach Who Christ Is* campaign. Through this historic endeavor we seek to raise \$350 million to strengthen parishes, Catholic education and faith formation throughout the Archdiocese of Chicago. Every parish in the Archdiocese will participate in this important initiative before the end of 2016. Thus far, the response has been tremendous. Archdiocesan-wide we have raised more than \$210 million towards our goal. That is 60% of our goal. This is very inspirational, but there is still more to do.

Next Weekend is Commitment Weekend

Each parish has been assigned a target goal for the campaign. The goal for St. Priscilla is \$535,000. Keep in mind that we are asking families to consider a pledge over five years. The really good news is that we have already received pledges totaling \$137,725 from 57 families. That is 26% of our goal. Sixty percent of what you pledge today will remain at our parish. We want to thank those families who have given so generously to the campaign.

Next weekend, during all of the masses, we will give every parish family an opportunity to participate in the *To Teach Who Christ Is* campaign. Please take some time during the coming week to pray about and reflect on what you can do to support the campaign. Then come to mass next weekend prepared to fill out a pledge card.
